Regardez Moi is today the reigning Australian Grand Prix Champion 2008/2009. He has also just blasted a new Australian international Grand Prix record score at Equitana in late November 2008 of 68.25%. Regardez Moi is experiencing an all-time high - 2008 culminated with winning the Australian Final of the World Cup and so qualifying to compete at the World Cup Finals in Las Vegas, USA, from April 15-19. This is where the top 15 qualifiers from all over the world will meet head to head. This is also Regardez Moi's first performance in the Northern Hemisphere and a great lead-up to the World Championships next year. Regardez Moi is slowly but surely closing the gap between Australian Grand Prix standards and the standards of the superstars in the Northern Hemisphere. These are very exciting times as Regardez Moi builds in confidence and stature and sweeps aside one record after another. Normally a service fee will cost \$3,500.00+GST, however, on March 8 three service fees will be offered with no reserve and is a great opportunity to become involved. Please note that unfortunately with Regardez Moi, there is no chilled or frozen semen available so all mares must travel to the Ryans at Heatherbrae in the Hunter Valley, NSW.

The legendary AEA Metallic has proven himself to be an inspiration for the dressage sport in Australia as a top class performer as well as siring some of the most outstanding moving foals ever bred in this country.

Since his arrival in October 2005 Metallic's performance has gone from strength to strength and he started Prix St George at just six. El lost a year of competition but nevertheless Metallic had wins at medium and advanced at the Westernport Championships in early March 2009. We are expecting him to do Grand Prix within a year because everything comes so easy to this super-talented stallion. An awesome mover with a powerful, elevated and cadenced trot, he not has only a front leg with that rare knee action, but also an extreme active and powerful hind leg. The canter is just out of this world. So huge and big off the ground! The walk has a very big over track and just super impressive. Genetically, Metallic has been very much performance bred, by Metall who is by the Dutch black pearl in breeding Olympic Ferro, three times team silver winner including at the Sydney Olympics. Metall's dam is by the legendary G Ramiro who bred not only jumpers but international dressage horses.

Jive Magic has at long last become a full-blown Grand Prix stallion. His final hoorah in the small tour was the Sydney International CDI Show in May 2009, winning every class against huge fields, including PSG, Inter I and Inter I freestyle. He also won award for the highest score for any horse in any class over the whole weekend!

From there he ventured into his first Inter II class and won. Rozzie was heartened by this, and at his first Grand Prix he was third. He won the next one. And at the next one he won again! And do you know what? The general consensus is that Rozzie and Jive are going to be very difficult to keep out of the Australian team at the World Equestrian Games (WEG) next year in the USA. Youngstock by Jive Magic at home have been having great success - his very first-born foal was sold at auction in Melbourne for \$10,000.00 + gst, called Jeff the Chef. Today Jeff the Chef, 7yo, is Advanced Dressage Champion of the USA with Silva Martin. At the National Dressage Championships 2008, another Jive youngster, Karingal Anastasia (Tor Van der Berg), owned by Sharna Glover and bred by Karen Tracey, was not only the Australian Elementary Champion but also the Australian Medium Champion! Jive Magic has become a serious blue chip investment for those mare owners who backed him early. His progeny are very much sought after and most top riders in Australia have youngsters by either Jive Magic or Regardez Moi or better still, youngsters which are a mixture of both stallions!

Mixed with his outstanding Rubenstein and Donnerhall pedigree is Lanthan (dec), a black 16.2hh stallion (German, imp). Lanthan sires beautiful, elegant, modern warmbloods renowned for their temperaments and talent in both dressage and showjumping. Romance marks the dawning of a new age in dressage, following in his father's footsteps and winning and placing with up to 78% and winning horse of the year titles. Romance has just begun advanced level dressage and is training piaffe, passage and one times. He has an even, regular walk with a clear rhythm, a trot with Grand Prix written all over it, while the canter right from the day he was born had magical talent – what would be collected for any other horse is something Romance can do on a loose rein, with great expression. Extremely intelligent, our biggest problem is keeping him amused without training him too quickly since he never says no, and usually tries to find something harder to perform! Romance is a beautiful and obviously upstanding individual - closer analysis makes him incredibly exciting from a technical point of view and we feel that he is part of a dawning age of dressage in Australia. Fame R is the first foal to be by Fiji R out of a Jive Magic/Regardez Moi cross mare, exactly the role imagined for Fiji R. Regalia R is out of Lucilla, a full sister to Stirling Liberty, who jumped at World Cup level as a 7yo with Olympian Gavin Chester and was the sire of Snowy River Blackwood, one of Australia's leading Grand Prix dressage horses with Di Jenkyn. Regardez Moi at the time of writing is Australian Grand Prix dressage champion and Jive Magic has just hit Grand Prix and is already winning. His sire, Jazz, represented Holland at the World Equestrian Games in 2002 in the dressage team. Fiji's grandsire Florestan sired a number of Grand Prix competitors at the 2008 Beijing Olympics. Florencio was the Young Dressage Horse 5yo and 6yo World Champion. Allowing for all of this, surely there cannot be a more spectacularly bred dressage colt in Australia today! Just as an add on, remember that Harvard is by perhaps the highest profile Trakehner in the world today, His Highness. Fame R is a really beautiful type and already travels with his front end seriously elevated. He is the first foal from his mother Jamie R. This is a wonderful opportunity to reach out into the future.

Sire Aspen has elastic movement and enormous jumping ability that carried him to 2nd place in the 6yo jumping class at DJWTS. Aspen's pedigree features the proven jumping lines of Souvenir and Aachen. Souvenir has been a major influence on jumping lines in Australia - his immediate progeny featured Mickey Mouse - ridden by Vicki Roycroft to 10th place at the World Championships Stockholm 1990, and further down the line Peppermint Grove, dual gold Olympic medallist with Gillian Rolton. Aachen (imp) is one of the most influential stallions to have been used in Australian performance horse breeding. He produced the internationally successful eventers Aava (WEG 2002 and Olympics 2008) and Belcam Aberdeen 4 **** Eventer with Jessica Irvine-Brown as well as multiple FEI Dressage and World Cup Showjumping horses. Aspire is young and exciting and has already started his dressage career showing huge talent. He has started jumping at local jump club with classy clear rounds and at his first ODE start was immensely impressive. In all three of these disciplines he has won or placed. Aspire is a very classy eye-catching individual with great paces, a light and soft way of galloping and a jump that is both of technical excellence and inclined to be seriously airborne. 

Bradgate Park Magnum is an astonishing eventer that comes from an amazing family, being a full brother to Heath Ryan's top eventer Mystery Whisper, the youngest 3-star winner in the world when he won Sydney 3DE last year 2008 and EFA Horse of the Year 2007. Bradgate Park Magnum is being campaigned at pre-novice level with lots of wins to his credit. He usually wins or is in the top few in the dressage phase. Cross country he is fast, clever in front of his fences and bold. Showjumping he is very scopey, has great technique both front and back and bascules classically. As a straight dressage horse he has won official elementary classes and is schooling all the medium work and pretty well all the advanced work with tempi flying changes, shoulder in half pass, extensions, and canter pirouettes. As a straight showjumper he has from very limited outings won at 1.10m classes and is very comfortable jumping around 1.30m tracks. Like his full brother, we expect Bradgate Park Magnum to easily do well as a 3*** eventer. For sale through no fault of his own, definitely a 2012 Olympic possibility.

Londoner went on with Mary Hanna to win the NZ Grand Prix Trans Tasman competition beating the entire NZ and Australian teams! Russet R is so bred in the blue combining the best bloodlines in the world with Australian Grand Prix dressage performance bloodlines. She will make the most amazing top-of-the-range riding horse but also represents a collection of bloodlines pretty well unavailable in one mare anywhere in Australia. A unique individual.


