



Champions of the Future

Here we go again for a second year with Auction of the Stars at Boneo Park on the Mornington Peninsula in Victoria. This year it will be slightly different and much more hectic as the weekend of March 6/7 coincides with the Boneo Park Summer Dressage Championships. This will include a Grand Prix competition on the Saturday and a Grand Prix freestyle on the Sunday. Both of these competitions are likely to see Regardez Moi and Jive Magic go head-to-head in a full-blown official competition - really hectic when you consider that Saturday morning will see the viewing of the youngstock at 11am, the Grand Prix competition, then the stallion masterclass, free and open to the public at 6pm. In the masterclass, all of the Auction of the Stars stallions will take part. Traditionally all of the riders carry a lapel microphone to ride and commentate on just where their training is at that particular moment in time and how they have achieved the level they represent. Auction of the Stars has six stallions in this masterclass: Byalee Briar, Byalee Romance, AEA Tuschinski, AEA Metallic, Jive Magic and Regardez Moi. The riders commentating will include Ann-Maree Cambridge (Lourey), Dirk Dijkstra, Rozzie Ryan and Heath Ryan. In conjunction with the masterclass is a BBQ, free and open to all the competitors and public spectators who care to come along. All welcome!

Sunday will again see Auction of the Stars do a public viewing of youngstock at 9am. Following this will be the Grand Prix Freestyle where again some of Australia's best dressage riders will perform, and once again Jive Magic and Regardez Moi are likely to go head to head. After the freestyle is the auction itself at 1pm.

2010 is of particular interest to Auction of the Stars and indeed all Australians - the World Equestrian Games will be held later this year in the USA in September/October. Both Jive Magic and Regardez Moi will be vying for selection on the Australian dressage team. Many of the youngsters in this auction carry these bloodlines and are clearly being produced for riders interested in competing at the top. Also vying for selection in the Australian dressage team will be Victory Salute owned by Carolyn Lieutenant and ridden by Brett Parbery. Victory Salute is by Salute (imp, now deceased) who probably represents one of the most influential international performance bloodlines in Australia at the moment. Laced through this auction are a number of youngsters carrying the Salute bloodlines. Auction of the Stars is completely focused on producing youngstock that will go on to represent at Olympics and World Equestrian Games levels. Today the success of these bloodlines is beyond debate. Of course Auction of the Stars is all about the future and developing new bloodlines that will build on top of the established bloodlines - hence the introduction of our young stallions with AEA and Byalee. Without question there will be individuals presented in this auction that will participate in top level competition in years to come. Auction of the Stars is very much committed to being part of the Australian frontlines and the Australian quest for gold medals. Good luck!

Regardez Moi had a huge year in 2009 – Australian Grand Prix Dressage Champion 2008-2009, he also represented Australia at the World Cup Dressage Finals in the USA at Las Vegas, the first of what we hope will be many Australian representative honours for Regardez Moi. 2010 is also expected to be a big year with the World Equestrian Games being conducted in the USA this time at Lexington, Kentucky. We hope to be there!

At home Regardez Moi has been having great success with his progeny. At our Queensland auction last year (Toowoomba August 15/16), the five Regardez Moi lots sold at an average of \$17,950.00!! This has to be some sort of Australian record. The Regardez Moi youngsters are showing great talent for piaffe and passage and are likely to find Grand Prix relatively easy. We promote the statistic that only 6% of the horse population has a vocabulary of movements that allows them to have the potential to do Grand Prix. We genuinely feel that in the very near future in Australia, the riders that have invested their time, money and soul into the Jive Magic youngsters and the Regardez Moi youngsters will pretty well dominate dressage in Australia. The legendary AEA Metallic has proven himself to be an inspiration for the dressage sport in Australia as a top class performer as well as siring some of the most outstanding moving foals ever bred in this country.

Since his arrival in October 2005 Metallic's performance has gone from strength to strength and he started Prix St George at just six. El lost a year of competition but nevertheless Metallic had wins at medium and advanced at the Westernport Championships in early March 2009. We are expecting him to do Grand Prix within a year because everything comes so easy to this super-talented stallion. An awesome mover with a powerful, elevated and cadenced trot, he not has only a front leg with that rare knee action, but also an extreme active and powerful hind leg. The canter is just out of this world. So huge and big off the ground! The walk has a very big over track and just super impressive. Genetically, Metallic has been very much performance bred, by Metall who is by the Dutch black pearl in breeding Olympic Ferro, three times team silver winner including at the Sydney Olympics. Metall's dam is by the legendary G Ramiro who bred not only jumpers but international dressage horses.

Jive Magic has at long last become a full-blown Grand Prix stallion. His final hoorah in the small tour was the Sydney CDI in May last year where he won every class including the highest score for any horse in any class over the whole weekend! From there he ventured into his first Inter II class and won it. Rozzie was heartened by this, and he followed up with third in his first Grand Prix and 1st in the next. Entered his next Grand Prix and he won again! And do you know what? The general consensus is that Rozzie and Jive are going to be very difficult to keep out of the Australian team at the World Equestrian Games in the USA this year, especially after his performance at the Victorian Dressage Festival in December where he was 3rd to Victory Salute in the Grand Prix freestyle. Jive Magic has also shown great success with his youngstock. His first foal, Jeff the Chef, was sold at an early Auction of the Stars in Victoria for or \$10,000 plus gst and at 7yo with Silva Martin, he is the American National Advanced Champion. Karingal Anastasia (Tor van der Berg) was not only elementary champion but national medium champion at the 2008 Australian National Championships. Taylor Made Jackson (Jess Willard) was preliminary champion at the National Young Rider Championships 2009. Jive Magic has been a long time coming but here he is, a serious blue chip investment for his early backers. Progeny from Jive Magic are very much sought-after and most of the top riders in Australia have youngsters by either Jive Magic or Regardez Moi or better still, a mixture of both!

Romance is an exciting stallion by Regardez Moi, who has set the dressage scene alight, being reigning national Grand Prix champion and top 10 World Cup dressage final in Las Vegas this year, while looking to be on the WEG team in Kentucky next year. Mixed with his outstanding Rubenstein and Donnerhall pedigree is Lanthan (dec), a black 16.2hh stallion (German, imp). Lanthan sires beautiful, elegant, modern warmbloods renowned for their temperaments and talent in both dressage and showjumping. Romance marks the dawning of a new age in dressage, following in his father's footsteps and winning and placing with up to 78% and winning horse of the year titles. Romance is winning championships at medium level, already successful at advanced level and is training in piaffe, passage and one times. He has an even, regular walk with a clear rhythm, a trot with Grand Prix written all over it, while the canter right from the day he was born had magical talent – what would be collected for any other horse is something Romance can do on a loose rein, with great expression. Extremely intelligent, our biggest problem is keeping him amused without training him too quickly since he never says no, and usually tries to find something harder to perform! Romance is a beautiful and obviously upstanding individual - closer analysis makes him incredibly exciting from a technical point of view and we feel that he is part of a dawning age of dressage in Australia. AEA Tuschinski is named after his sire Tuschinski, outstanding son of the world-famous dressage stallion Krack C. Krack C is a GP stallion ridden to huge success by Olympic gold-medal winner Anky van Grunsven. Tuschinski is considered by many to be the best dressage progenitor in Europe. His foal report showed that he passes his flexibility, suppleness and presence on to his offspring, that they showed extra special self-carriage and a hindleg technique. AEA Tuschinski's dam is Paronia B by Gribaldi. Gribaldi is the sire of Tortilas, record-breaking with Edward Gal on 90.75%!!!! Gribaldi was 1995 champion of stallion selections and 1996 champion in his stallion performance test, winner of the 4yo stallion competition (1997) and reserve champion in the Pavo-Cup (4yo dressage horses). AEA Tuschinski's breeding - and his movement - is clearly phenomenal. AEA Tuschinski had his first two novice dressage starts where he won and scored over 67%!!!! The judges are honestly mesmerized by AEA Tuschinski - so will you be!

This is a stunning young state-of-the-art broodmare, specifically bred by Heath and Rozzie to produce Olympic competition dressage horses. Ryans already have a full sister to Jive's Delight R called Jumping Janie R, which has already produced top-priced foals for the AOS auctions. Jive's Delight R has produced a Regardez Moi filly, retained by Ryans, and she is back in foal to Fiji R, due October 2010. Jive's Delight has three magnificent paces, a great marching rhythm in the walk, huge power and bend in the trot as seen above and a lovely light and balanced canter with a really up-in-front way of going. This mare does represent a fantastic collection of state-of-the-art genetics. Jive Magic is blasting his way through Grand Prix and certainly is a contender for the Australian Team at the forthcoming World Equestrian Games in the USA this year. Diamond Delight carries the Donnerhall and Pik Bube bloodlines through Don Ramiro. Snowshoes carries Salute blood, which is probably the most influential bloodline in Australia today when it comes to Grand Prix international dressage horses like Victory Salute, Stirling Stilton and DP Christopher. 

Miracle is by the champion Grand Prix stallion Richmeed Medallion, also campaigned by Ann-Maree Lourey. Miracle is out of the Byalee matriarch Stirling Savannah, who is in turn by the superb stallion Salute, sire of Victory Salute (Brett Parbery), a contender for the WEG in Kentucky this year, GV Stirling Stilton, (WEG Jerez with Heath Ryan), Rhythmic (elite listed with Lisa Martin) and DP Christopher (NSW State Champion) as well as a wealth of successful competitors in showjumping and eventing, such as Staccato, the world's top-ranked eventing stallion. Brilliance – Stuart to his friends – is a big beautiful boy who simply takes your breath away standing still – and then he moves. Conquest is a quality 3yo gelding, beautifully put together, well balanced and extremely correct, ready to break in. He has a delightful, trainable nature and his movement will impress the most fastidious dressage rider. He has three pure paces - a huge overtrack and swing in the walk, big powerful trot and elastic uphill canter. Even as a foal he showed the ability to sit on his haunches and play in piaffe and passage. Sire Jaybee Apache was the highest-scoring stallion at Dressage with the Stars as a 3/4yo and his sire, Aachimedes, is arguably the most successful sire of dressage horses in Australia today. BP Conquest has been lightly freejumped, showing great technique and scope, which is not surprising with the bloodlines of Carbine, Chico D'Oro (GP showjumper longlisted for Montreal Olympics) and of course the legendary Souvenir (through Koyuna Supreme), whose bloodlines have been represented in the past six Olympic Games. Conquest is a half-brother to BP Destiny who sold well at the last auction. The lucky buyer can choose their discipline with this talented youngster, who is bred to succeed!

This is a wonderful all-round broodmare – a lovely ground-covering trot, pretty face, great walk and uphill canter and the most beautiful temperament. “Pinki” was a disaster on the racetrack – she is far too gentle a soul for that – despite carrying the performance bloodlines of both Northern Dancer and Vain. Pinki was the special pet of her trainer’s wife and has entered the world of breeding because she was too good to be wasted. Pinki is an easy broodmare – in foal first go and proved easy with live cover – and at the age of seven is perfectly poised for a breeding career. She is due in November to Byalee Briar (imp) by the world’s top Grand Prix dressage stallion for seven years, Bjorsells Briar 899. Pinki is easy to handle in every way and can be caught, led and handled by non-professionals. She would be the ideal broodmare for someone getting back into the world of horses, for someone looking to enjoy the experience of their first foal, or for someone who wants the warmblood they can’t quite afford. Byalee Briar is an extremely laidback stallion who can be trusted with even inexperienced handlers and Pinki has a 50/50 chance of a chestnut/palomino foal. Pinki’s foal is bred either for dressage or jumping and will without doubt be worth more than the price of the mare. It is bred to excel – this is the lot you will kick yourself for not buying if you don’t take her home!

Roundelay R is truly impressive from every angle. He already has a magnificent topline that just oozes power and self-assurance. He has a deliberate walk, and a trot that just rockets up into the air with amazing bend, power and charisma. The canter is ever-so-calculated with bend, balance and deliberation blended together. Roundelay R is by Regardez Moi, Australian Grand Prix Champion in 2008-2009, last year Australian representative at the World Cup Final in Las Vegas, USA, and this year firm favourite to make the Australian WEG dressage team. Roundelay R is out of Wham R, a spectacular tall Weltmeyer mare. She is black with four white socks and moves like a panther. Weltmeyer is the sire of Wie Weltmeyer and also Warum Nicht, both spectacularly successful in the European Grand Prix arenas. Wham R is out of Marge R, by Richmeed Medallion (imp). Richmeed Medallion was a Grand Prix stallion himself (by the sensational Danish stallion May Sherif) with Ann-Maree Lourey and sired her champion Australian Grand Prix dressage horse Byalee Magic. Roundelay R is a sensational collection of Grand Prix genetics and as soon as you see him we think you will agree he is a sensation just in his own right.

Fame R is the first foal to be by Fiji R out of a Jive Magic/Regardez Moi cross mare, exactly the role imagined for Fiji, and the first foal for Jamie R. Regalia R is out of Lucilla, full sister to Stirling Liberty, who jumped at World Cup level as a 7yo with Olympian Gavin Chester and was the sire of Snowy River Blackwood, Australian champion Grand Prix dressage horse (Di Jenkyn). Regardez Moi was the Australian Grand Prix dressage champion 2008-2009 and Jive Magic has just hit Grand Prix and is already winning in a big way. Both Jive Magic and Regardez Moi are likely contenders for the Australian Grand Prix Team to go to the World Equestrian Games (USA) later this year. Jive Magic's sire, Jazz, represented Holland at the WEG in 2002 in dressage. Fiji's grandsire Florestan sired a number of Grand Prix competitors at the 2008 Beijing Olympics. Also Florencio was the Young Dressage Horse 5yo and 6yo World Champion. Surely there cannot be a more spectacularly bred dressage colt in Australia today! Fame R is a really beautiful type. His front end is seriously elevated. This is a wonderful opportunity to reach out into the future.

Jonglerr R is classically bred and has such a classical interpretation of all three paces. A real technician, he has a wonderful walk with great overtrack and a great walk-march rhythm. The trot is in the air with a natural inclination to stay under from behind. He has impressive reach in his trot stride yet still maintains an elegant bend and curve in all of his joints. Jonglerr R has great balance and always seems composed. He is by Jive Magic who has just stormed onto the Australian Grand Prix scene. Jonglerr R is out of Regalia R, who is by Regardez Moi, who was the Australian Grand Prix Champion 2008-2009. Both Jive Magic and Regardez Moi will be vying for the Australian Grand Prix dressage team to go to the World Equestrian Games later this year in the USA. Regalia R was one of the very first Reagrdez Moi fillies to be offered for sale as a weanling but was so spectacular that Heath re-purchased her during the auction at AEA Burong in Winchelsea, Victoria. She certainly has not let Ryans down. Regalia R is out of Lucilla, full sister to Stirling Liberty, who campaigned at just 7 years of age at World Cup showjumping level with Olympian Gavin Chester. Perhaps most important, Stirling Liberty sired Snowy River Blackwood (Di Jenkyn), one of the top Grand Prix combinations in Australia for many years. Jonglerr R is a classic.

Damzel is a beautiful warmblood Arabian who can really move, but due to a cosmetic hoof injury has not been shown. She is an excellent mare to cross with Grand Prix candidate Byalee Romance. Damzel offers first-time or financially astute breeders the opportunity to step into the world of warmblood breeding without spending a fortune, opening the door to success in Olympic disciplines. Damzel has a wonderful floating trot and an easy-to-handle temperament, and the foal will inherit this along with the temperament of Herr Dom Perignon, known as a perfect gentleman. A magnificent black 16.2hh stallion, he was WA Royal Champion and WA State dressage champion. His offspring are also successful, for example Dom Leisel Royal Supreme Champion Warmblood (WA), Glencairn Dimity (dressage, Qld). Herr Dom Perignon's sire, Herr Dominator (black 17hh) was also Royal champion, an advanced dressage champion and sire of many performance horses including Benalbyn Classic and Pia (Melbourne Royal Champion). He was by the impressive black imported Hanoverian stallion Domherr, sire of Kibah Tic Toc – dual Olympic Gold champion. This foal will excel at dressage or jumping – plus you get the mare - what a bargain!

Jessey R



Jessey R is a beautiful colt and perhaps a little distinctive from the rest of the Ryans' draft. He is a very elegant type but like a teenager, gangly knees and hocks and elbows everywhere. He is performance-bred and does have some thoroughbred much closer than his other cousins in this catalogue. Jessey R has paces that show extraordinary bend and action. His photo shows his most conventional moments! Jessey R is by Jive Magic out of Rosemary R who is by Regardez Moi. Both of these stallions are likely to be part of the Australian World Equestrian Games Grand Prix dressage team later this year in the USA. The grand dam, Spice R, is by Salute, sire of Victory Salute (also likely to be part of the Australian WEG dressage team later this year). Salute is also the sire of Stirling Stilton (who was part of the Australian dressage team at the 2002 Jerez). Spice R is a full sister to Sydney Lights, sold to China for \$250,000, and also a full sister to Mr Shirvington, advanced eventer (David Middleton). Spice R is also the dam of Fairy Lights R, spectacular eventer with Emma Armstrong. Spice R is out of the fantastic thoroughbred mare Pashris (ASB), one of the few amazing thoroughbred broodmares to be used by Ryans in recent times. Jessey R is distinctive in his interpretation of life and distinctive in his genetics.



This is a beautiful colt that is fine, elegant and possesses beautiful movement. Unfortunately the above photo does him no justice; interested parties are well advised to look at Julio R in the flesh. Julio R is going to have a refined and sculpted physique with real elegance. He has a lovely walk, a trot that covers the ground and displays great bend in all of the joints. His canter is very light and again has an elegant ballerina-type interpretation. Julio R is by Jive Magic, a likely candidate for the Australian Grand Prix dressage team later this year at the World Equestrian Games in the USA. On the dam's side Julio R is out of the Regardez Moi mare Ribena R. Ribena R is a full sister to the spectacular filly Ridotto R, also being sold in this catalogue. Regardez Moi, like Jive Magic is also a likely member of the Australian Grand Prix dressage team for this year's WEG. Right down on the bottom of Julio's pedigree is Shakira. Shakira is a very influential mare with Ryans and is by Salute, sire of Stirling Stilton (represented Australia in Grand Prix dressage in 2002 at the WEG in Spain) and Victory Salute, also tipped as a hot favourite for the Australian WEG team this year. So Julio may well have a father, a grandfather and a cousin in the Australian WEG team this year - probably a first anywhere in the world!


AEA Tenacious

Tenacious is one of the first foals by the already well-known AEA Tuschinski. Tuschinski carries serious dressage bloodlines from Krack C and Flemming. His dam lines carries Gribaldi, sire of the world record-breaking Moorlands Totilas. In Tuschinski's pedigree in both sire and dam lines, a majority of the dams have acquired significant recognition within the Dutch KWPN stud book. Tenacious' dam is by Dutchman, who is a producer of many dressage horses including Grand Prix dressage gelding WS Nevada with Caroline Wagner, international three-star event winner Mr Dumbeldore with William Fox-Pitt, and World Cup showjumpers AEA Dutch Lorel and the stallion Dutch Choice. As you can see, the breeding and movement of this youngster is extraordinary. Tenacious has the ability to take you to the top.

This is an eye-catching red bay with four white socks, a star and snip. She is green broken to saddle and showed enormous trainability. She is a beautiful and correct type with three very good expressive paces. She has been lightly freejumped and demonstrates a classic technique and is careful but keen. Her sire, Highborn Powerlifter, is a foundation warmblood stallion in Australia being the first to pass performance testing in all three phases – jumping, eventing and dressage – with Fiona Hughes. He has produced many successful dressage horses (Valhalla Precious Gem, Highborn Baden, BP Power Trend and BP Power Dynasty) and showjumpers (BP Power Ranger and BP Bond Dot). Powerlifter's sire is the influential Valuta (Gert Donvig) who was Olympics shortlisted. The dam line is a successful Anglo performance line in all disciplines. In addition, this mare has a PPT to AEA Tuschinski (see front of catalogue). This is a rare opportunity for a discerning buyer.

Jubilation R is a magnificent colt that will grow up into an oil painting. He has a beautiful head set on to a naturally arching neck, in turn set high on his shoulder. Jubilation R travels over the ground in all three paces with his forehand elevated in a very aristocratic presentation. His walk is clear and regular, his trot is light, bendy and ballerina-like, his canter has a soft flow that barely touches the ground – ever-so-beautiful. Jubilation R is by Jive Magic, who is storming his way into Australian Grand Prix dressage history, already a contender for selection in the Australian World Equestrian Games dressage team. The dam of Jubilation R is Raggedy Ann R, by Regardez Moi, Australian Grand Prix Dressage Champion 2008-2009. In 2009 he represented Australia in the World Cup Dressage Final in Las Vegas USA, and is a strong chance for the Australian WEG team with Jive Magic. Raggedy Ann R is out of Melissa R who is by Richmeed Medallion (now deceased) who was also a Grand Prix dressage stallion with Ann-Maree Lourey. Richmeed Medallion is by May Sherif, to this day the only stallion in the world to sire two World Cup Final dressage winners, Andiamo (Sven Rothenberger) and Matador (Kyra Kyrklund). Jubilation R is a sensation.
