## A MESSAGE FROM HEATH

June 2014



Here we go again, however, this time at the new venue at Horseworld in Maraylya which is close to Windsor, Sydney. The Sydney Polo Club for the past few years has been great, however, our policy is to keep moving after two to three years. Horseworld was the scene of Sydney CDI dressage competitions before the Sydney International Equestrian Centre (SIEC) came into existence for the Sydney 2000 Olympics. Consequently, Horseworld houses many great ghosts and memorable performances from legends from a past era. It feels a bit like a homecoming. However what we bring this time to Horseworld is a bit of Australia's future.

We have some magnificent unbroken youngsters which are bred in the purple who definitely have legitimate claims on greatness in years to come. In amongst this splendid collection are the genetics that danced their way around the London 2012 Olympics. One of the youngsters, Richard the Lionheart, is a full brother to Rattle 'n' Hum, currently competing at Prix St Georges/Inter 1 level with Kaz Roe from Queensland. Rattle 'n' Hum is being tipped as the next superstar Grand Prix horse in Australia. Interesting to note that Rattle 'n' Hum was also sold some years ago through the AOS auctions. Richard the Lionheart carries some of the most influential competition bloodlines in the world in Rubinstein, Angelo, Donnerhall, Jazz and May Sherif.

Again we have some super-doooper broodmares on offer with of course the most spectacular being Socialite R. Socialite R is the mother of the 2012 Olympic horse Mystery Whisper. Socialite R is back in foal and expecting a full brother or sister to Mystery Whisper. This is possibly the first time ever in Australian history that an Olympic broodmare has ever been sold at auction. Being pregnant with a full brother or sister to an Olympic horse, it may well be the first time this has ever happened in the world!

Brilliant young horses under saddle we have in abundance. These days the youngsters are bred for the job and how good they are is anybody's guess. What we can guarantee you, is that they are very good horses and maybe in amongst them is an Olympic medalist. Certainly the catalogue

cover photo is Fireworks R, who would be the quietest high quality 3yo that I have ever ridden. If you look at the photo of him cantering on the front cover it is just freaky, with the front legs just so elevated and light. If you look in the catalogue you will find a trotting photo. Again, freaky.

The walk is regular, four beat and shows good over track. He is bred in the blue and you would have to ask, "Well, if he is that good, then why is he for sale?" We breed 70 broodmares a year ourselves and so we just have to sell or get swamped. Presently, I personally am riding three full-blown Grand Prix horses: 8yo Johnny Depp went through an AOS auction, 9yo Utopian Cardinal went through an AOS auction and had the most spectacular CDI dressage competition just gone by in Sydney at the end of April, and of course the 18yo superstar Regardez Moi won the Grand Prix Special and the Grand Prix Freestyle at the above-mentioned CDI. I am also riding the 8yo Aspire R, sold through an AOS auction and who had his first Three-Star 3DE the weekend before the Sydney CDI. He was one of five only clears cross-country, really tough on account of the event being a final Australian World Equestrian Games selection trial. On top of this, I ride up to 12 other horses a day so we have to sell. We have been doing this for more than 25 years and we would like to think that the product we have on offer is second to none in Australia and rivals the best in the world. We are offering a brilliant collection of young horses under saddle.

Finally, we have a few brilliant seasoned competition horses that have performed with success and also have a place as schoolmasters. Kaludah Sjef is 14yo and has won at official advanced level. Kaludah Sjef has the most brilliant canter pirouettes, flying changes down to every second stride and a wonderful big soft engaged trot that makes you feel like you have velcro stuck to the seat of your pants.

Ladies and gentlemen, June 14th and 15th, 2014, at Horseworld will be a fascinating study of high quality horses, some great riding, some displays pursuing insight and some new owners who will feature in Australia's future history. I hope to see you there.

## A MESSAGE FROM ANN-MAREE

### HE WHO HESITATES ...

'He who hesitates is lost' ... it was inspired if not penned by English poet Joseph Addison, and it has a very literal interpretation here at Auction of the Stars!



He (or she!) who hesitates will literally lose the bidding war and in so doing lose the horse ... and in so doing may lose their dream.

You know the kind, 'When I ride Grand Prix ...', 'When I have a horse good enough to really concentrate on ...', or even 'If I had a good horse, I wouldn't be coming last ...'

If you don't bid, you can always say that you failed in your equestrian dream because you didn't bid high enough to buy the horse of your dreams, and that 'if only' you had bought that horse at the auction, things might be different.

There truly is no time like the present. Heath Ryan once told me that we have to push evolution or we will be dead long before we evolve into the rider we want to be. How true is that? It is one of those mantras that forces me onto a horse in a howling gale in the middle of winter when sensible people are tucked up in front of the fire with a book.

But life is short. Own your dream. Don't be afraid to come to the auction in case you don't get the horse you want. If you don't come and see what happens, you surely won't! If you do come, you never know what will eventuate. Sometimes your dream might sell for far more than you think it will, but the pendulum does swing in the opposite direction too, and sometimes there are real bargains to be had, when your dream can turn into your reality because you win your bidding war!

Don't be afraid to bid! If you don't bid, you can't win. Be brave! Remember that Auction of the Stars offers top-up finance on the horses offered by Byalee and Ryans. That means that you can bid 20% further than you think you can. And we even offer full finance, just check with us first. Don't decide before you arrive that you will never achieve your dream – make an effort to be successful.

# RIDDEN HORSE TRIALLING



This is one of the outstanding opportunities offered through the AOS selling program. We would encourage all riders who are slightly interested in the ridden horses to pluck up the courage to trial these horses in the official trialling times. Of course you are very welcome to trial these horses by prior arrangement in the weeks preceding the auction. Most people do suffer from the thought of riding in front of a crowd on the official trialling day. Our take on this is that if you are too embarrassed to look out for your own interests, then certainly nobody else will. Also, if you have dreams and ambitions, secret or otherwise, and being embarrassed is the biggest obstacle you have to overcome, then really life is not too bad. Realistically you will have to overcome much bigger obstacles than just being self-conscious or embarrassed. Get out there, trial these horses and take advantage of a great opportunity.

At the auction you do have the unique advantage of comparing one horse against the other. This comparison opportunity is exactly what happens in competition, one horse immediately compared against another, a phenomena which is very difficult to replicate when buying a horse privately. Riding is a passion discipline and in most instances when buying privately a prospective purchaser falls in love with a horse and buys it. In the auction situation, a prospective purchaser is much more likely to weigh up the pros and cons of each horse on a comparative basis. Of course, falling in love with the horse is a critical ingredient for success but we at the AOS would encourage you firstly to select your next horse on an intellectual level, then follow your heart and fall in love with the horse. We all know of people that have bought horses that didn't turn out to be everything they had hoped for but nevertheless, love the horse and persevere even when it is clear they should sell and start again. Treat the auction trialling as a day at the office.

We encourage everyone to trial each horse that goes close to falling into their wish list category. Keep in mind that sometimes a horse that reads and looks mediocre in the catalogue actually turns out to be lots better in real life than you had expected. Conversely, some horses will catch your imagination in the catalogue, and then be disappointing in real life. Once you ride more than two horses you will lose track of details on each horse so we encourage you to write notes on each horse immediately after trialling them. Also, watching a horse being trialled by other riders is a great way of assessing honesty and rideability.

The first official trialling is at 1pm on Saturday 14th June and we would encourage all interested parties to take advantage of this Saturday trialling. This does give you as the potential buyer the opportunity to have another ride the next day Sunday 15th June at 9:30am. This also gives you enough time to research the horses and talk to the owners.

The basic format of trialling is that two or three horses come into the arena and are shown off for the first five minutes by their vendors, basically warming up and just gently running through the horse's routine. Then people wishing to have a little sit are invited to come forward. Prospective buyers organise to trial a horse by approaching the AOS representative, who takes a list of names so as to keep the trialling ordered, and also signing the appropriate waivers. Each trialling is tailored to each rider's individual needs, keeping in mind that the first and foremost priority is safety, and of course the well-being of the horse. It is a very hectic schedule with two sessions of public trialling plus the auction, all in two days, so horse welfare is a major consideration. We are of course very aware of also servicing the riders' needs.

Fiji R is an exciting young imported stallion campaigned and trained by young rider Breanna Tilitzki. Breanna has had great success with Fiji R, winning with scores over 75%. These scores have been posted at major competitions including Sydney competitions. Fiji R is now competing with success at PSG and Intermediare I, performing this year at Australia's elite international, Sydney CDI. Fiji R has the quietest of temperaments and often will be found at Young Rider competitions with just Breanna and her Mum as rider and guardian. This temperament Fiji R passes on to his foals. Fiji R has quite remarkable paces with a very distinctive walk. Trot is fully suspended with a definite ballerina poise between beats. Canter is beautifully balanced and uphill with super easy flying changes. Fiji R is sensationally bred with his sire Florencio being both the 5yo and again the 6yo World Champion young dressage horse. Florencio I is by Florestan I who has emerged as one of the recent very important dressage lines in Germany and who has a number of Olympic offspring to his credit already. On the dam line is a mix of Trakehner through Hohenstein and thoroughbred through the Hill Hawke line. The Hill Hawke line has become famous as a dam line by also being the dam line of the Welt Hit line. Many of the top Australian riders have a Fiji R youngster growing out in their backyard including riders such as Rachael Downs.

## Flaxen chestnut colt 01/01/2010 15.2hh

Wow is a stunning little all-rounder, winning his first official dressage outing ever at elementary level on more than 70%, and medium level on over 67% as 4yo, training two-time tempi changes and half-steps and clearing over a metre with great joy when he is allowed to jump, given his age. Wow, campaigned by Grand Prix rider Dimity Lourey, is a chunky power machine, a pocket rocket with the most amazing work ethic, set to excel in the collected work at Grand Prix. His talent and versatility come as no surprise, given that his sire, Wie Weltmeyer, was a Grand Prix showjumper and Grand Prix dressage horse before his international Olympic dressage career kicked off with UK rider Emma Hindle. 
