A MESSAGE FROM HEATH

For the last 5 or 6 years I have been doing a two-day clinic, usually Tuesdays and Wednesdays, nearly every week of the year. These clinics appear at all types of locations all over Australia.



Attending these clinics are usually a couple of riders who are reasonably well down the path to being advanced competition riders and the balance is made up of dressage enthusiasts, a few eventing enthusiasts and often some teenagers who have the whole world still in front of them. All of these riders without exception are enthusiastic and hard-working. Some of them are wonderfully talented whilst others tend to be of average talent.

My job, as I explain to each and every pupil, is not to give a riding lesson as there are lots and lots of coaches in Australia who are wonderful mentors and instructors as far as developing a riders techniques and abilities. No my job is to accept what the riders already have in the way of skills and encourage very accurate application of pre-existing skills so that the horse responds in the best possible way. It is often amazing just how well an average Australian can ride when given direction on how to accurately apply hard won skills. It is my belief that should an average rider achieve 60% of their riding potential then they will ride at such a standard as to be a serious Olympic contender.

The big catch with riding is that this sport is all about a partnership between a horse and a rider. The saying that a chain is only as strong as its weakest link is a law of the universe and applies to all of us in everything we do. Riders or people in general are raised to have good manners and so when the horse does not go so well we are all quick to take the blame and excuse the horse. I am not completely opposed to this approach however it helps nobody and the training of the horse becomes remarkably more complex if in actual fact the rider taking the blame is inaccurate.

The more advanced we become and aspire to be the more accurate we need to be in our observations and directives. Sometimes short falls will be directly attributed to the horse. i.e. some horses are born with very little natural suppleness through the poll. This can be found in all breeds and especially the thoroughbred. Of course a horse that lacks suppleness through the poll seriously struggles to fold together in collection and does experience a certain amount of discomfort. These horses of course are much more difficult to ride on the bit.

So the point I am making is that in my travels I see lots of good riders with exciting potential riding horses that are going to find it very difficult to respond in an embracing way to the efforts made by their riders.

For a horse to embrace training he does need to be talented and made for the job. The biggest weak link in most Australian riders' equestrian efforts is that their horse struggles with performing well in the Olympic disciplines. The nature of the sport makes this even more complicated in that of course there is a special rapport between most horses and riders. So as a coach doing these clinics I am always very reluctant to suggest that the rider needs a better horse. Even when this is clearly so, the special partnership between horse and rider is something sacred and I always hesitate to damage this trust. The brutal truth however is that the best riders are sitting on the best horses. The best riders however on an average horse unbelievably become average riders!

This catalogue does present young horses that have been very carefully bred for the Olympic disciplines. Unfortunately I cannot give a guarantee but I can in all honesty promise that the likelihood of finding a talented Olympic discipline competition horse in this catalogue is hugely increased as opposed to searching for a new horse through normal avenues of horses for sale.

Already horses by the senior Auction of the Stars stallions are winning Grand Prix dressage, three-star eventing and competing at Olympic Games and World Championships. As the standard of riding across the world continues to go up it is very important that we in Australia are developing riding partnerships with very good horses. Good luck everybody.

A MESSAGE FROM ANN-MAREE

Every year I sell as many as 50 or more horses, of all shapes and sizes, from first ponies to Olympic-bred superstars.

And almost inevitably, most of the buyers I meet along the way will tell me that they feel they shouldn't buy the horse they have come to look at because they are 'not good enough' and 'the horse will be wasted'.



I have a well-practised response to that kind of conversation, where the rider is essentially putting themselves down. How do they know how good they can be until they try?

First of all, I point out that everyone, but everyone, makes mistakes as they learn, no matter what they learn. It is part of the process. If you were to learn to play the piano on a baby grand piano, the mistakes wouldn't sound as bad as they would on grandma's old un-tuned upright that has been through three floods. So play on the best piano you can find! You won't always hit the right note, but you will enjoy great rewards when you get it right, and the inevitable discordant notes will sound as sweet as they can.

Well, surprise, surprise, the same applies to horses. Let's face it, you are investing all your time and energy and often all your income in becoming the best rider you can be, achieving the best results you are capable of achieving, whether that be a CDI at Grand Prix level or a local adult riding club day.

And if you are putting in all that effort, you owe yourself the right to ride the best horse you can afford – without any of that ego-shredding discussion about whether you are good enough for it, or whether someone else might take it to Olympic level.

There are horses in this catalogue that most definitely COULD go to Grand Prix and have a really good go at representing Australia – they have the breeding and the background performance to prove it – but that doesn't mean they can't be your special horse. The horse you buy here at Auction of the Stars could be the one that makes you the best you can be. The horse is NOT wasted. It is helping you to achieve, it is giving you the best possible reward for your efforts.

We hope that today you will buy that special partner to help you be the best you can be. What is your goal? How can we help? Could you buy a youngster and set yourself a time frame to work towards being ready to ride it when it is broken in, using an older more experienced mount in the meantime? Could you buy a youngster under saddle and work towards a goal of gradually taking over the ride? Could you buy an under-saddle star now and see just how good you can be?



DIRECTIONS

From the Monash Freeway, continue along Princes Fwy, Berwick. Take the ramp to Clyde Rd Exit, Berwick. Turn right onto Clyde Rd, Berwick, after the ramp. Continue along the Berwick-Cranbourne Rd, Berwick. At the roundabout take the 1st exit onto Thompsons Rd, Clyde North. Turn left onto Smiths Lane, Clyde North. RIDDEN HORSE TRIALLING



This is one of the outstanding opportunities offered through the AOS selling program. We would encourage all riders who are slightly interested in the ridden horses to pluck up the courage to trial these horses in the official trialling times. Of course you are very welcome to trial these horses by prior arrangement in the weeks preceding the auction. Most people do suffer from the thought of riding in front of a crowd on the official trialling day. Our take on this is that if you are too embarrassed to look out for your own interests, then certainly nobody else will. Also, if you have dreams and ambitions, secret or otherwise, and being embarrassed is the biggest obstacle you have to overcome, then really life is not too bad. Realistically you will have to overcome much bigger obstacles than just being self-conscious or embarrassed. Get out there, trial these horses and take advantage of a great opportunity.

At the auction you do have the unique advantage of comparing one horse against the other. This comparison opportunity is exactly what happens in competition, one horse immediately compared against another, a phenomena which is very difficult to replicate when buying a horse privately. Riding is a passion discipline and in most instances when buying privately a prospective purchaser falls in love with a horse and buys it. In the auction situation, a prospective purchaser is much more likely to weigh up the pros and cons of each horse on a comparative basis. Of course, falling in love with the horse is a critical ingredient for success but we at the AOS would encourage you firstly to select your next horse on an intellectual level, then follow your heart and fall in love with the horse. We all know of people that have bought horses that didn't turn out to be everything they had hoped for but nevertheless, love the horse and persevere even when it is clear they should sell and start again. Treat the auction trialling as a day at the office.

We encourage everyone to trial each horse that goes close to falling into their wish list category. Keep in mind that sometimes a horse that reads and looks mediocre in the catalogue actually turns out to be lots better in real life than you had expected. Conversely, some horses will catch your imagination in the catalogue, and then be disappointing in real life. Once you ride more than two horses you will lose track of details on each horse so we encourage you to write notes on each horse immediately after trialling them. Also, watching a horse being trialled by other riders is a great way of assessing honesty and rideability.

The first official trialling is at 2.30am on Saturday March 16 and we would encourage all interested parties to take advantage of this Saturday trialling. This does give you as the potential buyer the opportunity to have another ride the next day Sunday March 17 at 8.30am. This also gives you enough time to research the horses and talk to the owners.

The basic format of trialling is that two or three horses come into the arena and are shown off for the first five minutes by their vendors, basically warming up and just gently running through the horse's routine. Then people wishing to have a little sit are invited to come forward. Prospective buyers organise to trial a horse by approaching the AOS representative, who takes a list of names so as to keep the trialling ordered, and also signing the appropriate waivers. Each trialling is tailored to each rider's individual needs, keeping in mind that the first and foremost priority is safety, and of course the well-being of the horse. It is a very hectic schedule with two sessions of public trialling plus the auction, all in two days, so horse welfare is a major consideration. We are of course very aware of also servicing the riders' needs.


